

Measures for the Establishment of the Curriculum Committee of the Department of Leisure Business Management of Kainan University

Article 1 These regulations are formulated in accordance with Article 4 of the regulations for the establishment of the curriculum committee of this school.

Article 2 The responsibilities of this Association are as follows:

1. The establishment, research and planning of compulsory and elective subjects for the professional courses of this department.
2. It is responsible for the review and coordination of teachers' class schedules.
3. The various teaching units within the school provide mutual support and coordination of teaching matters.
4. Evaluation and improvement of required and elective courses for majors.
5. Promotion of professional lectures, seminars and related activities.
6. Decisions on professional course exemption and credit transfer for transfer students and transfer students.
7. Formulation of the principles for blocking and deferred study of required major courses.
8. Review and revision of professional course outlines.
9. Proposals for other course-related matters.

Article 3 The dean of the department serves as the convener of this association, and the full-time teachers of the department serve as members. Each member has the right to discuss and express his opinions. The members of this association are unpaid positions with a term of one academic year.

Article 4 The Association will convene meetings as necessary and invite student representatives to attend the meeting; it may also invite experts, scholars, and industry experts from both inside and outside the school. Professionals and graduates who are invited to attend can express their opinions, but do not have the right to vote.

Article 5 The resolutions of various proposals of this association shall be sent to the executive meeting for discussion.

Article 6 Matters not stipulated in these regulations shall be handled in accordance with the relevant regulations of the school.

Article 7 After the regulations are passed by the department affairs meeting, they will be submitted to the college affairs meeting and the school academic affairs meeting for review and approval. It will be implemented later, and the same will apply to revisions.
