

Detailed rules for credit exemption for students of Department of Leisure Industry Management of Kainan University

106.9.13 The second department meeting of the 106 school year was adopted.

Article 1. In accordance with the provisions of the "Measures for the Credit Use of Kainan University Students", the "Department of Leisure Business Management of Kainan University" is formulated. "Detailed Rules for Students to Receive Rabbit Credits" (hereinafter referred to as these "detailed rules").

Article 2. Detailed rules for arriving in rabbits:

1. The principles for claiming credits are as follows:

- (1) Those whose subjects have the same name and content will be admitted after passing the course.
- (2) If the subjects have different names but similar nature, the applicant must submit the relevant teaching plan or syllabus. Submit it to the department meeting for deliberation; after deliberation and approval, the arrival will be approved.
- (3) When compulsory subjects are discontinued, added, changed to electives, or have their names and credits changed, they must be taken retaken or repeated. Those who take the course must be replaced by a course of similar nature after deliberation by the principal meeting.
- (4) In case of other special circumstances, arrival must be approved after review by the department's executive meeting.

2. If the number of credits is different, the principle of using a symbol to equal a rabbit is as follows:

- (1) If more credits are used to offset fewer credits, the fewer credits will be counted.
- (2) If there are insufficient credits in the original subjects, and the credits for the entire academic year are to be used as credits, the credits from the previous semester will be used as the principle. Still need to make up credits for the next semester (for example, four credits of economics originally taken can be used as credits for the previous semester of economics) Three credits, plus three additional credits in the next semester).

3. The points for credit subjects are as follows:

- (1) Universities and four-year colleges: Those whose scores do not reach 60 points will not be exempted.

(2) Five-year junior college: credits from the first to third grade are not allowed to be used as credits. Completion of subjects studied in fourth to fifth grade those whose scores do not reach 60 points will not be exempted.

Article 3. Arrival procedures:

1. Apply according to the schedule announced by the school. The supplementary credit is limited to one time.
2. Students must submit the application form for credit exemption, original transcripts, and course syllabus of completed courses to the Department Curriculum Committee for review nuclear.
3. Those who have objections to the review results of "credit credits" may submit a review to the department's curriculum committee within the specified time limit. But it is limited to one time.

Article 4. These rules shall be implemented after being approved by the departmental affairs meeting, college affairs meeting and academic affairs meeting, and the same shall apply when revised.
